Paternity action filed against Tiger Woods

Porn star Devon James has filed a paternity action against golfer Tiger Woods, two days after going public with allegations he fathered her son.

As the golfing superstar teed off at the U.S. Open tournament at Pebble Beach, California on Thursday, James filed legal documents in Manatee County, Florida, asking a judge to determine the paternity of her nine-year-old son Austin.

James insists Woods has never taken a paternity test to prove he's the father of her son, even though her mother, who currently has custody of the boy, claims a DNA test was performed in 2002 and proved the golfer was not the father.

The porn star is keen to force her alleged ex-lover to submit to DNA testing.

Considering this case, the samples should be collected from Tiger Woods (Alleged Father) and Devon James (Mother) and her 9 year old son Austin (Child). In order to collect the samples from Tiger Woods, the alleged mother needs to commence legal proceedings to obtain the court order (which directs Tiger Woods to consent to his DNA sample taken).

Finally the protein has to be removed which is achieved by adding a protease (optional but almost always done).
